## Application for Extension/Further Extension

### Notes for the Guidance of Applicants

1. A fee shall be paid to the Planning Authority by an applicant in respect of an application for an EXTENSION or a FURTHER EXTENSION. The amount of the fee payable shall be €2.00
2. Attention is directed to Section 42 of the Local Government (Planning and Development) Act 2000 which sets out strict requirements relating to applications for EXTENSIONS.  
*The requirements are as follows*
  - (a) That a proper application is made in accordance with Regulations made by the Minister
  - (b) That any requirements of, or made under, the Regulations are complied with.
  - (c) That the Planning Authority is satisfied that the relevant development commenced before the expiration of the appropriate period; that substantial works have been carried out pursuant to the permission during that period and that the development will be completed within a reasonable time.
3. When making an application to FURTHER EXTEND an application;-
  - (a) The application must be made in accordance with Regulations made by the Minister
  - (b) Any requirements of, or made under, the Regulations must be complied with.
  - (c) The Planning Authority must be satisfied that the development has not been completed due to circumstances beyond the control of the person carrying out the development.
4. It should be noted that the Planning Authority will only extend the period for as long as it considers it necessary to enable the development to be completed.
5. An application to EXTEND or FURTHER EXTEND a permission may not be made earlier than one year before the expiration of the appropriate period sought to be extended.
6. An application to EXTEND or FURTHER EXTEND must be made prior to the end of the appropriate period of the planning permission
7. An outline planning permission can only be extended where an approval / permission consequent has been granted for same.
