

## **CAPPAMORE, or TUORAGH:**

A village, partly in the parish of Doon, and partly in that of Tuoragh, barony of Owneybeg, 10 miles (S.E.) from Limerick; containing 711 inhabitants. This village is situated near the banks of the small River Mulcairn, over which is a handsome stone bridge, and on the road from Limerick to Templemore; it consists chiefly of two irregularly built streets. Fairs are held on 20 April, 1 July, 20 September, and 12 December, for cattle and pigs. A spacious chapel is now in progress of erection for the R.C. district of Cappamore, which includes the parish of Tuoragh and part of the parishes of Doon and Abington.
