

## **BALLINGADDY:**

A parish, in the barony of Costlea, 2 ¼ miles (S.) from Kilmallock, on the road to Kilfinnane; containing 1031 inhabitants. It comprises 5615 statute acres, as apportioned under the tithe act, of which about 400 are mountain, and the remainder is generally in a good state of cultivation. Mount-Russell, the residence of J. Russell, Esq., is beautifully situated at the foot of the mountain range, commanding an extensive view over a very rich vale. It is a rectory and vicarage, in the diocese of Limerick, and forms part of the union of Kilmallock: the tithes amount to £280. The ruins of the old church are situated near Riverfield; and adjoining the church-yard are 24 acres of excellent glebe. In the R.C. divisions it forms part of the union or district of Kilmallock; the chapel is a small thatched building. There is a parochial school, in which are about 40 boys and 30 girls.
