INSTRUCTIONS & CONDITIONS FOR APPLICANTS

1. A site location map showing the townland and indicating where the connection is required should accompany this application.

2. (a) Connection fee and road opening licence fee will be determined following receipt of completed application form . You will be advised at that stage if you have to apply for a road opening licence.

Meters are required on all connections other than single domestic houses.
- (b) A map or sketch showing the townland and indicating where the connection is required should also accompany this application.
- (c) Domestic Connection

An outside tap will not be allowed in place of a connection for domestic purposes
- (d) Livestock Tank Connection

A connection for a cattle tank will not be granted until such time as a properly constructed tank fitted with a ballcock in a separate enclosed chamber is installed. The tank shall be laid level on soundly constructed supports.

3. You may call at the Area Office where you will be given assistance in completing the form. Thus errors may be avoided and time saved. You should be as clear as possible about the exact location of your house. For a water connection some distance from your house, *ie.* Cattle troughs please give detailed location. Where a new house is being built, it helps to give the name of the contractor.

4. Send your application form to the appropriate Limerick County Council Area Office from the list below. The application should be forwarded in good time before the permission sought is required. Make sure that the form is fully completed.

County Council Area Office, Rivers, Annacotty, Co. Limerick.
County Council Area Office, Gortboy, Newcastlewest, Co. Limerick.
County Council Area Office, Rathkeale, Co. Limerick.
County Council Area Office, Kilmallock, Co. Limerick.

5. Your application for a water connection will be assessed by Limerick County Council. No work relating to the proposed connection should be carried out until you receive written approval.

6. You are advised not to undertake any work or expense until you are informed that approval for your application will be granted. For water supplies the normal

connection is a ½ " (12mm) diameter. A boundary box shall be installed on all connections.

7. It is an offence to open a public road or footpath without permission. No one is entitled to interfere with a local authority watermain without permission.
8. All plumbing should be completed to a suitable standard before the connection to the main will be made. For connections to housing estates and similar developments the watermain is to be pressure tested and approved by a Chartered Engineer.
9. Approval to connect to a water supply does not guarantee an uninterrupted supply of water.
