

## **MURROE:**

A village, in that part of the parish of Abington which is in the barony of Owneybeg, 8 miles (E.S.E.) from Limerick, on the road from Abington to Newport; containing 41 dwellings and 256 inhabitants. This little village stands near the boundary of the counties of Tipperary and Limerick, in the vicinity of the Slieve-Phelim range of mountains; though very favourably situated for trade, it is a poor, neglected place. It is a constabulary police station; and has fairs on 29 April, and 27 October. Here is a R.C. chapel, a large handsome building; also a dispensary.
