

HERBERTSTOWN:

A village, partly in the parish of Ballynard, and partly in that of Cahircorney, barony of Small County, 6 miles (N.E. by N.) from Bruff, on the road from Limerick to Hospital. It is a constabulary police station, and has large pig fairs on 15 January, 17 March, 28 June, and 7 November. Here is a large R.C. chapel, which was erected in 1836 at an expense of £800.
