

BALLYEGRAN:

A village, in the parish of Castletown-Conyers, barony of Upper Connelloe East, 5 miles (N.W.) from Charleville; containing 172 inhabitants. This small village, consisting only of a few thatched cabins, is situated on the road from Charleville to Ballingarry, and gives name to the R.C. union or district, comprising the parishes of Castletown-Conyers, Kilmeedy and Drumcollogher; the chapel is a small neat building. Not far distant are the remains of a heathen temple. – See Castletown-Conyers.
